Signature Programs

Signature Programs are annual programs with high public visibility. You may not know everything that we do, but if you live in the Crofton Area, you've probably been at one of these events.

Crofton Kiwanis 10K/5K Run – Usually held on the second Saturday in June, the 10K/5K navigates Crofton Parkway and the streets of Crofton and it attracts hundreds of runners of all levels of ability. This is also the primary annual fundraiser for the Kiwanis Foundation of Crofton.





Crofton Kiwanis Halloween Parade - & Costume

Contest – Held along Crofton Parkway on the Saturday before Halloween, this is a full parade with bands, dancers, antique cars, and much more. There is also a costume contest held before the parade. Hundreds of residents come out every year to see the parade.

Flags for Heroes – For two weeks around Veterans Day and again around Memorial Day, the Crofton Kiwanis Club displays U.S. flags along MD Route 3. Each flag is sponsored by a resident, and many have tags with details of loved ones that have served or are serving.





Parkway Flags – The Crofton Kiwanis Club sponsors U.S. flags on all 76 light poles along Crofton Parkway each year.


Serving the Community

The Crofton Kiwanis Serves the Community In many ways and the hands-on programs are some of the favorites of many members.

The **School Break Lunch Box** program provides kids who need food assistance with food during holiday breaks.



Every year the Crofton Kiwanis raises over \$2,000 for the Salvation Army by staffing **bell ringing** over three to four weekends at a local grocery store.



Twice a month the Crofton Kiwanis Club provides a meal for the residents of **Sarah's House** homeless shelter.





Each year the Crofton Kiwanis Club organizes the Crofton Chili Cook Off and Crofton Pie Contest that raise money for the Crofton Chrisitan Caring Council's **Baby Pantry and Food Pantry**.

Twice a month the Crofton Kiwanis members hold **Bingo for the residents** at Autumn Lake Health Care.



Serving Students
